Pancakes Aplenty

Sweet or savory, pancakes are enjoyed in many diverse countries. Here's how they stack up across the globe:

Crepe. Thin and airy, these iconic French pancakes are typically folded around fillings such as chocolate, whipped cream and fruit.

Blini. This tiny yet fluffy Russian pancake has become a trendy appetizer, often topped with sour cream and caviar.

Bing. In China and other parts of East Asia, you'll find many varieties of these pancakes. Sometimes, ingredients are cooked directly into the batter, such as the scallions in cong you bing.

Kaiserschmarrn. Austria's famous "scrambled pancake" is also beloved in Bavaria, the German region known for Oktoberfest. A large, freshly cooked pancake is torn into pieces and caramelized in butter and sugar, then sprinkled with powdered sugar.

Cachapa. These Venezuelan pancakes are made with freshly ground corn kernels, giving the batter a lumpy texture. They're often topped with cheese or pork and folded in half.



A popular American St.
Patrick's Day tradition is a meal of corned beef and cabbage.
While not a true custom of the Emerald Isle, it can be traced to Irish immigrants who came to the U.S. at the turn of the century. They substituted corned beef for their native dish of Irish bacon and added cabbage since both ingredients were readily available and much cheaper.



Scent Study

Testing a person's sense of smell might help predict their chances of developing Alzheimer's disease. A 2016 study found that people who had trouble identifying scents such as menthol, clove, pineapple and lemon seemed to be at a higher risk for Alzheimer's. The findings could lead to an inexpensive and noninvasive way to identify those who would benefit from treatment. Early diagnosis and intervention is very effective in slowing or preventing progression of the disease, researchers say. More studies are planned.


