On Saturday, May 13, Chef Bryan Taylor and his team will be preparing a fantastic meal. Jordan Preston will entertain us with delightful music.



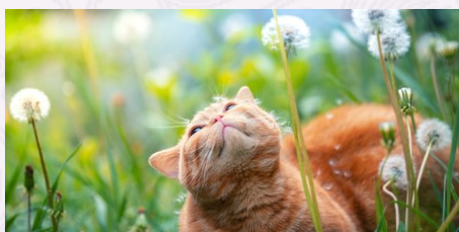

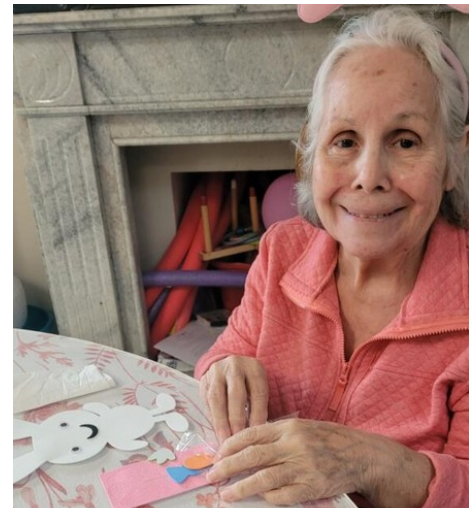

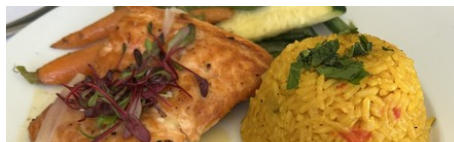
